# A NOTE FROM THE CHOREOGRAPHER:



A crab emerges as surprised to see me as I am him. I mimic his mannerisms, his quirky side-step, while we watch one another. I move away slightly, duck and trickle quickly away. I give him space to dance. After a time, I fall back into the dark, moving to my own drifting thoughts under the night sky. Intentionally daydreaming. I move contorting, distorting, and embodying the memory of creatures I've seen and dream about meeting again. They surprise, delight, and mesmerize. I play with these ideas, movement is both contrasting and complementary. Imagining the weightlessness of the moments surrounded by the bustling underwater world below. Fish swim past,

body seeming suspended in a swirling school. I flow, spiral and try to smoothly, weightlessly, whirl into the next. They creep out between rocks and from corals and retreat as if they were never there at all. I sneak, I peek, I strike out with limbs and pause, alert. Sometimes they scamper, shift, and drift across the bottom other times they stare and you stare right back, caught in their spell. ~ Notebook, October 2023

Welcome to our underwater world of Biome.

As a dance MFA candidate at UW-Milwaukee, my current research investigates awe, wonder and world-building in contemporary dance performance. In making dances, I strive to create worlds that the dance both takes shape in and simultaneously informs. I refer to this constructed world as a "choreographic ecosystem" as its design contains multiple elements of the visual and sonic that together, shape the world being experienced.

In preparation for the world of *Biome*, I reflected upon experiences scuba diving and translated the awe-filled experiences, impressions, and sensations into the terrestrial body. On a journey into environmentalism, and fascinated by the ocean, I am particularly interested in the preservation of these ecosystems, coral reef conservation and ocean biodiversity. How can wonder draw us in, connect us and ignite a spark for change? *Biome* is an underwater world, a fusion of ideas, and a culmination of these areas of embodied research. This embodiment of ideas took form in states, shapes, movement quality and direction, and I am excited to share this research with Milwaukee.

I was absolutely thrilled when Christal Wagner (DPMKE Artistic Director) suggested that my MFA thesis concert be the second concert of Danceworks Performance MKE's 2023-24 season. It has been a wonderful experience working with longtime collaborators Allen Russell (Composer), Colin Gawronski (Lighting Designer), Christal Wagner and the artists of DPMKE, to bring the vision of *Biome* to life.

Working out of my garage, I designed the set pieces for the immersive pre-show experience. I longed to have my own take on the concert going experience so we transformed studio B as the entrance into the world, the shallows before you move into deeper waters. Part structured improvisation and part art installation, studio B exists this weekend as a reef bustling with activity, reminiscent of some of my favorite dive experiences. The creatures inhabiting the space, immersed in projection. Follow their curious movements, and playful gestures, as you go deeper into the underwater world with Russell's majestic compositions flooding the space and Gawronski's lighting design enhancing the scene.

Taking your seat in studio A, I invite you to settle in, stash the trash under your seat, and feel free to chat as others finish enjoying the pre-show experience. Perhaps consider your

thoughts on the experience thus far... When you think about the ocean, what emotions come up? What creatures come to mind? What images? A curtain speech will play overhead and that will be your cue that the performance is about to begin.

As the movement and music swirls about, allow it to sweep you into our choreographic ecosystem. We invite you to wonder, to become curious about the creatures you see before you, to become invested in their world as it is yours also. Stay with us as the scenes gently shift and the elements of visual and sonic work together to morph into anew; creatures emerge and then disappear, the environment before you will shift. There is a moment where you will be cued to action. I appreciate you being here, for diving in, and I thank you in advance for your subtle yet impactful choreographed participation. I hope you enjoy the evening's experience.
